



Due to the current Covid-19 guidelines we've had to assess the way we conduct recording sessions.

We want to ensure that we provide the safest possible environment to work in, that we're able to maintain the standard of creative output that we strive for and that you all expect of us at Young Thugs.

The following guidelines and practices for the phased reopening of the studio should help to keep us creating in these uncertain times:

1. When entering the building at the main entrance, everybody must immediately wash/sanitise their hands before proceeding further into the building.
2. We'll be operating an enhanced cleaning process at the end of each session. This will include: the sanitisation of door handles, handrails and taps. This will also include musical instruments such as Guitars, Keyboards, synths and anything else that can be touched.
3. There will be alcohol-based hand sanitiser available throughout the studio.
4. Alcohol wipes will be provided next to headphone stations. Clients are requested to only use the headphones provided to them at the beginning of a session, and to wipe down headphones/headphone mixers/cables etc after use.
5. We will be providing disposable microphone 'pop shields', that will be thrown away at the end of every session.
6. A maximum of three people to occupy the studio and control room at any given time (including studio staff).
7. If a band member is not required for tracking, we respectfully ask them not to attend the studio.
8. If you are feeling unwell or showing any signs of Covid-19 related symptoms, please do not attend the studio. Instead, please contact us on jonny@youngthugs.com so we can discuss rearranging the session.
